What is UPM Memory Portal

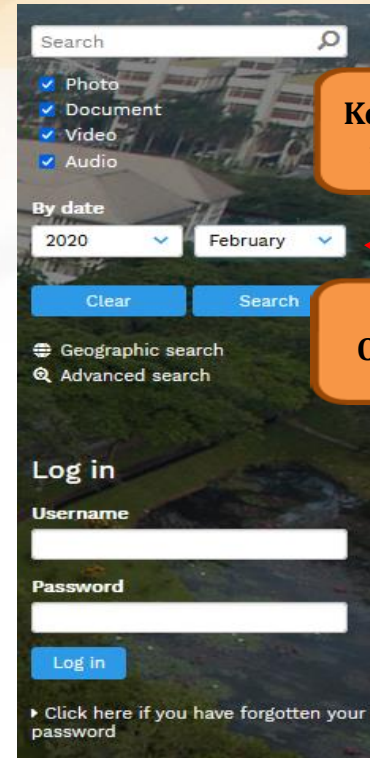
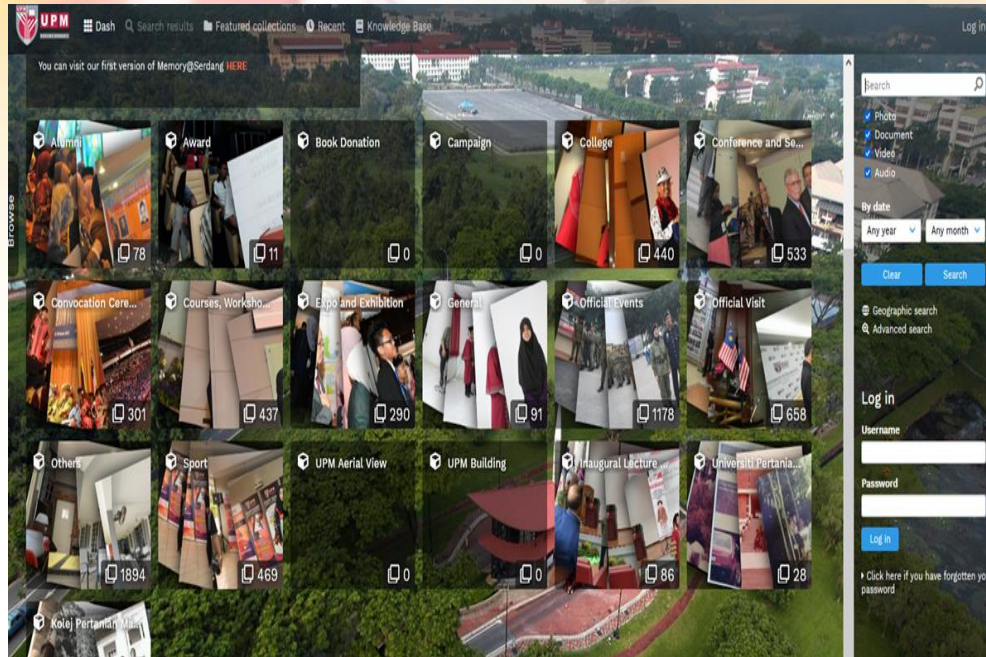
